Pope Francis said that the Holy Year "has much to say" to the world of education and schools. Recalling the Jubilee's focus on 'Pilgrims of Hope,' the Pope stressed that a good teacher is a man or woman "of hope" because they dedicate themselves with trust and patience to a project of human growth. "Their hope is not naive, it is rooted in reality and sustained by the conviction that every educational effort has value and that every person has dignity and a vocation worthy of being cultivated."



"God's' educational method is one of closeness, compassion, and tenderness," noting these three qualities are essential. "Like a teacher who enters the world of their students," the Pope said, "God chose to live among people, teaching through the language of life and love."

This also applies to parents and carers – since they are the first educators of their children.
