Once again, many thanks for your generosity from those parishioners, and visitors, who have over the last few weeks either used the electronic donation machine at St Philip Neri or the QR code to contribute to the parish. As you will have seen, it is not complicated...... and not just for the 'younger' ones! Thank you also for taking the time to gift aid the majority of these donations.

This additional way of giving to the weekly collection continues to see an increase over the short period since we adopted it as an additional method of giving for the increasing number of people who don't carry cash (of all ages!). As was said earlier, it works alongside our current method of collections – there is no need to change the way you currently give.
