As you will have seen, it is not complicated...... and not just for the 'younger' ones! Thank you also for taking the time to gift aid the majority of these donations.

This additional way of giving to the weekly collection continues to see an increase over the short period since we adopted it as an additional method of giving for the increasing number of people who don't carry cash (of all ages!). PRAYER FOR PEACE: The Holy Father asks that Monday 7 October, the memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary, to be a day of fasting and prayer for peace in the world. Accordingly, Bishop Patrick, together with all the Bishops across England and Wales, is asking parishes to do all they can to both inform parishioners of this message and request from the Holy Father, and to help as many as possible to participate in this action, calling for the gift of peace wherever there is conflict. **There will be Exposition at 5.00pm and Rosary at 5.30pm at St Philip Neri Church on Monday 7 October followed by our usual Mass at 6.00pm.**

SYNOD: The conclusion of Pope Francis's Synod of Bishops on **synodality** opened on the 30/09/2024 with of a two-day spiritual retreat.

The key themes of the SYNOD are "listening, communion and participation,"

Of the 368 participants, 272 are bishops and the rest are a mix of priests, deacons, male and female religious and laity **Wednesday October 2**, marks the official opening of the synod itself with a Mass in St. Peter's Square at 9:30am (Rome time), and the first working session that afternoon at 4:00pm., which will begin with a greeting from Pope Francis.

There will be four public events along the way: Two on Oct. 9, and two more on October 16. The themes of the public sessions are: "The people of God, subject of mission"; "The role and the authority of the bishop in a synodal Church"; "The mutual relationship between the local church and the universal Church"; and "The exercise of primacy and the synod of bishops."

On Friday, October 11, there will be an ecumenical prayer service in Rome's Piazza of the Proto-Martyrs, where, according to tradition, St. Peter was crucified upside down. The date, October 11, marks the 62nd anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council in 1962.

We pray for the SYNOD - that the Spirit of God will blow in and through the participants and all of the Church.
