JUBILEE



The theme of this World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, chosen by our beloved <u>Pope Francis</u>, is "Seeds of Peace and Hope".



In proclaiming the Kingdom of God, Jesus often used the image of the seed. As the time of his

Passion drew near, he applied that image to himself, comparing himself to the grain of wheat that must die in order to bear fruit (cf. *Jn* 12:24).

Seeds are buried in the earth, and there, to our wonder, life springs up, even in the most unexpected places, pointing to the promise of new beginnings. We can think, for example, of flowers springing up on our roadsides from seeds that landed up there almost by chance. As those flowers grow, they brighten the grey tarmac and even manage to break through its hard surface. In Christ, we too are seeds, and indeed, "seeds of peace and hope."
