JUBILEE - ADVENT

Franciscan theologian, Ilia Delio, describes Advent as a time when God is waiting for us to wake up and make God's presence real and alive in the world. It is not a time of waiting for Jesus' birth but of recognising that we ourselves need to wake up to the call to be the face of Christ to those with whom we live and work, especially those made poor and vulnerable. Christ is already with us.



Advent is about awakening to a new sense of love

Some people are already awakened to the call to be Christ for others and Nano Nagle, the foundress of the Presentation Sisters was an Advent person – someone who understood that God's love had to be spread through our everyday actions. As Pope Francis reminded us: "This is what it means to be a man or woman for others: to stand in solidarity with those on the periphery of society, humbly providing the opportunity for them to be seen, to matter, to know that their life story has value..." (Apostolic Exhortation on Consecrated Life).

We are all invited to be true Advent people, not just in the lead-up to Christmas, but every day. As we light the Advent Candles in our homes and churches, let us give thanks for those we know who are examples of selfless giving and for the light of Christ beckoning us to help light the world with love - one person, one act of kindness at a time.

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS TO CATHOLIC PRIMARY ACADEMIES (RECEPTION YEAR) - CHILDREN BORN BETWEEN 01/09/2021 AND 31/08/2022: The deadline for submitting an application for a school place is 15th January 2026. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you should also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You must also include the supporting evidence as required with this form, ie a baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable; contact the parish of baptism if you don't have a copy); failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.
