PROPOSED REMOVAL OF DEDICATED BUS SERVICES TO CATHOLIC SCHOOLS: We encourage all parishioners to take part in the Nottinghamshire County Council consultation (link below) and make your voice heard regarding the proposed removal of dedicated bus services to Catholic schools. Removing dedicated bus services to Catholic schools would have serious consequences for families across Nottinghamshire. Catholic schools such as All Saints Catholic Voluntary Academy and St Philip Neri with St Bede Catholic Voluntary Academy serve wide geographical areas, with many pupils travelling significant distances each day to access faith-based education.

Catholic schools play a vital role in nurturing not only academic achievement, but also faith, moral values, community, pastoral care and commitment to spiritual development. Removing dedicated transport would create major barriers for families exercising their right to choose a Catholic education for their children. The proposals would disproportionately affect Catholic families, particularly those on lower incomes, those living in rural communities, and children with additional needs. Reliance on public transport would raise serious concerns around child safety, long unsupervised journeys, unreliable connections, and increased stress and fatigue for pupils.

There are also wider concerns about increased traffic congestion, pressure on public transport, declining attendance, and the long-term sustainability of Catholic schools if access becomes too difficult for families.

Dedicated school transport provides safe, reliable, and accessible travel for hundreds of children. Removing these services risks undermining parental choice, equality of access to education, and the wellbeing of young people across our Catholic school communities. Thank you for your support.
