BISHOP PATRICK'S ANNOUNCEMENT: Both Canon John and Fr Liam will be leaving the parish of Our Lady and All Saints on Monday 14 September. Canon John has served as Parish Priest since May 2017, and Fr Liam as Assistant Priest since November 2024.

Canon John will become the Parish Priest of the parish of the Annunciation, Rushcliffe, which comprises the former parishes of West Bridgford, Radcliffe-on-Trent, Cotgrave, and Keyworth, while continuing to serve the Diocese as Vicar General.

Fr Liam will become Parish Priest of Our Lady and the Beauvale Martyrs, Erewash Valley, comprising of the former parishes of Eastwood, Ilkeston, and Stapleford.

Your new Parish Priest will be Canon Paul Newman, who is currently the Parish Priest of Our Lady and the Beauvale Martyrs. Your new Assistant Priest will be Fr Evarist Kaniki, who is currently the Assistant Priest in the parish of the Annunciation, Rushcliffe.

We know you will offer a warm welcome and your prayerful support and encouragement to your new priests. The parish is very fortunate to continue to be served by two priests.

THE GOVERNMENT'S GREAT BRITISH SUMMER SAVINGS SCHEME takes place between **25th June and 1st September**, with a temporary reduction on VAT from 20% to 5% on children's meals in restaurants, children and family tickets to cinemas, theatres, concerts, exhibitions and a wide range of other attractions. THE NATIONAL CONVERSATION: Is a chance for everyone to contribute ideas about how to shape a more united future for England. OPPOSE ASSISTED SUICIDE: As you may have seen, the proposal to legalise assisted suicide which was rejected by the Lords in the last parliamentary session is returning to the Commons in exactly the same form on **Friday 11th September**. Our Bishops have asked us to oppose this legislation, on the grounds that it undermines respect for the innate value of life; that it could lead to vulnerable people feeling pressured into ending their lives; and that it risks putting many hospices and care homes in the position of no longer being able to operate. The Bishops have asked us to contact / write to our MPs once again, to express our opposition to this bill. They have provided materials to help us to do this on their website (www.cbcew.org.uk/opposing-assisted-suicide/). There is only a short time before the bill is debated on 11th September. Please contact your MP as soon as possible.

REMINDERS FOR THOSE WITH A DBS - Subscription to the Update Service: Volunteers who are subscribed to the update service need to action the email sent by DBS every 12 months to renew their subscription, otherwise it will be deactivated and we will need to carry out a new DBS check when their 3-year renewal is due. **ID Cards Renewal Process:** ID cards for those who visit homes have an expiry date that corresponds to the date the DBS is due for renewal. Expired ID cards should be sent to the Diocese Safeguarding Office and a new one will be issued if the DBS has been renewed.
